I wish for you a wonder-filled Christmas and hope for a blessed new year. I love the Christmas holidays, not only because we celebrate the birth of our Savior, but because it seems that people are happier and more receptive to spiritual things during this time of the year. I hope that Christians can influence people with whom they come in contact. Jesus is the only hope we have for salvation

Dear Dr. Utley,

First of all I want to express my admirations about your ministry and the way you have chosen to do it. May god bless you and all the people you love.

Some time ago I came to the conclusion that the on-line free Christian resources can give good chances to a minority Christian community, like Bulgarian protestant churches, to survive in difficult circumstances and I started my own project in such direction, providing some filtered materials on-line. You can see my project at http:/abv.hristianski.net ("hristianski is youth slang for "Christian network" in Bulgarian and "abv" is the "abc" in Cyrillic alphabet). Sometime later I discovered your commentaries and I have put the usable versions there too. As many Bulgarians speak English and Russian, I use such materials too, which makes my site attractive for Russian users. For the moment I intend to make connections to your "You can understand the Bible" you-tube sessions, specifically the versions with Russian subtitles. However, as my main aim is being useful to Bulgarians, I would like to ask your permission to translate them into Bulgarian language, so that they become available to wider Bulgarian audience. I would be very thankful if you can send me the Russian subtitle files. I will translate from English, but using the timing settings will make the work much easier as these languages are both Slavic. Of course, it will take time, as I am doing this alone in my free time.

About my self – I am believer since 1991 with conservative Pentecostal (AG) background. Married with 2 daughters, 41 years old. I have master degrees in pastoral counseling

and in strategic management, leadership and spirituality (secular). This September I defended PhD in leadership.
